The Lester Center of Entrepreneurship & Innovation is currently accepting applications for the Price and Turner Fellowships. These fellowships are awarded to eligible students interested in an entrepreneurial career; this year the awards consist of:

- Two \$5,000 Price Institute Fellowship awards, administered by the Lester Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation. The Price Institute Fellowships are designed to help identify and nurture entrepreneurial talent.
- One \$5,000 Turner Fellowship, awarded to an outstanding MBA student (Full-time or Evening & Weekend). The Turner Fellowship has been established to support MBA students in their entrepreneurial efforts.

Students must have at least one year of study remaining towards their MBA degree (Dual degree candidates are eligible in their first or second year). A faculty committee makes the selections based on academic achievements, entrepreneurial experience, career goals, and financial need.

It is the intention of both fellowships that any awarded funds be applied towards the student's direct educational expenses (i.e., tuition, books, etc.).

Eligible applicants need only complete ONE application to be considered for these fellowships. The deadline for submitting applications is 5 pm April 13, 2007. Further information and applications are available at <http://entrepreneurship.berkeley.edu/priceturner.asp>.
