Seminars in International Business ("SIB") are designed to introduce EW MBA student participants to the culture, history and business environment in various countries. Each SIB program focuses on a country and illustrates how business environments vary across cultures.

For SIB India, the spotlight is on **conducting business in a regulated emerging market**. India has always been a heavily regulated economy with bureaucratic restrictions on investment, employment, and business policy. The class will examine a variety of perspectives on doing business in India – regulators and bureaucrats, domestic firms, foreign firms, media, and NGOs. The goal is to develop a broad perspective on the complexity of doing business in a large emerging market.
