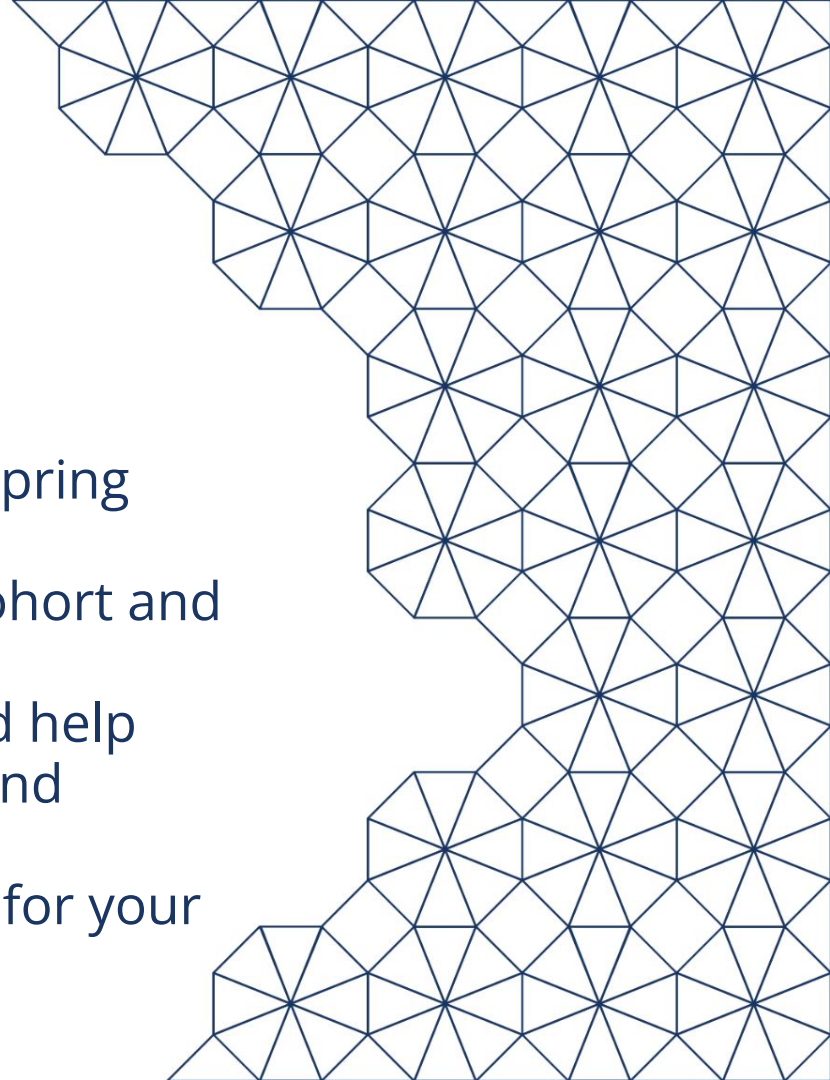
What are Cohort Representatives?

- Point of contact for cohort, faculty, and EWMBA Program Office around academics and student experience
- Academic Cohort Reps (ACRs) focus on classroom and academics
- Social Cohort Reps (SCRs) focus on student experience and community



What does being a Cohort Representative entail?

- Serving in the role for Fall and Spring
- Attending monthly meetings
- Acting as the liaison between cohort and faculty and the program office
- Responding timely to issues and help brainstorm creative, effective, and equitable solutions
- Improving the Haas experience for your classmates and future cohorts



What makes a great Cohort Representative?

- ❑ Enthusiasm
- ❑ Commitment to helping others
- ❑ Willingness to be visible to your classmates
- ❑ Ability to present problems in a clear and non-judgmental way
- ❑ Follow through
