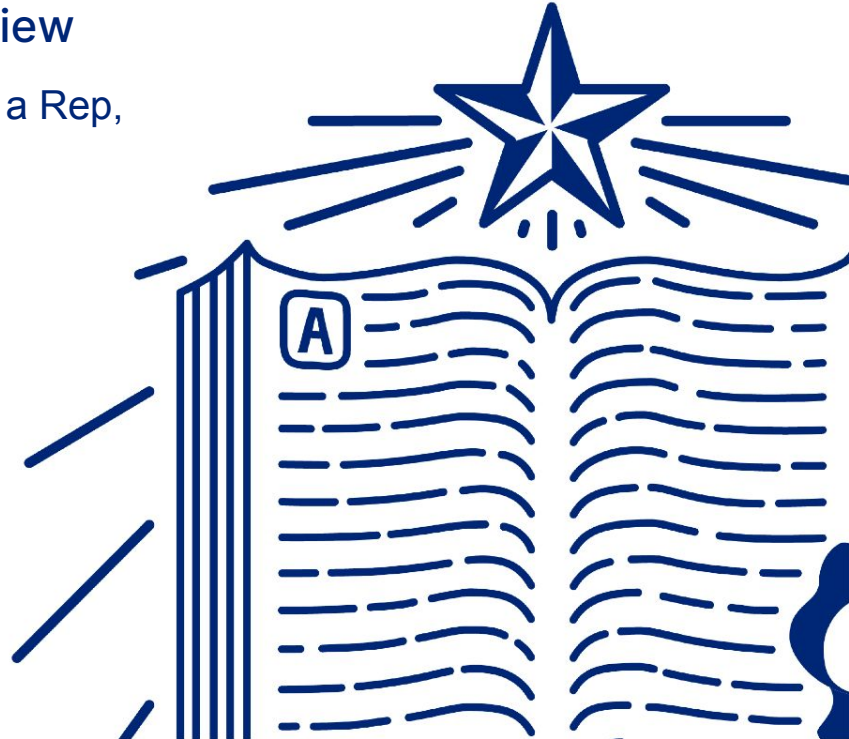

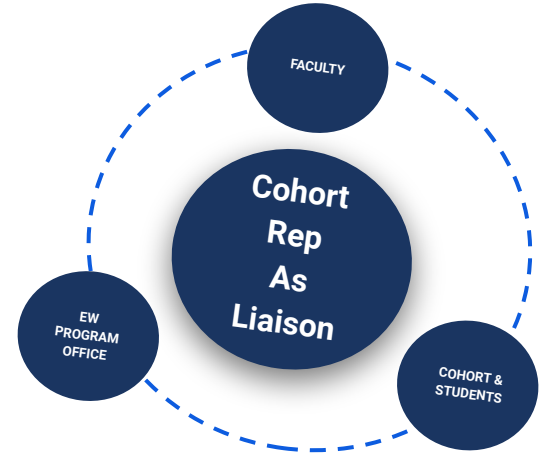
Social Representatives
