HAAS PREREQUISITES

Overview of Haas Prerequisites

- Complete a minimum of **60 semester units**
- Complete all **major prerequisite courses listed below with a letter grade** (must have a C- or higher)
 - If you repeated or took more than one course to fulfill a prerequisite, you must use the first attempt to satisfy the requirement.

Transfer Units

We will accept transfer credit / test credit for some prerequisites completed prior to your admission to Haas. Once you are a UC Berkeley student, however, you must take your remaining prerequisite requirements at UC Berkeley.

Lower Division Courses

- **Principles of Business, Economics, and Statistics**
 - UGBA 10X (must be taken at UC Berkeley) and
 - ECON 1 or ECON 2 and
 - Choose from one of the following statistics courses:
 - STAT 20
 - STAT 21
 - STAT 131A
 - STAT 134
 - STAT/DATA 140
 - STAT/DATA/INFO/CS 8 + UGBA88 or DATA C88S
- **Calculus:** two semesters of calculus – Calculus 1 and Calculus 2
 - Choose from among the following courses or course combinations:
 - MATH 16A + MATH 16B
 - MATH 1A + MATH 1B
 - MATH 16A + MATH 1B
 - MATH 1A + MATH 16B
 - MATH 53
 - MATH 54
 - MATH 56
- **Reading & Composition (R&C) Requirement**
 - Parts A (R1A) and B (R1B) of Reading and Composition.

Exam Credits

Advanced Placement (AP) Exams, International Baccalaureate (IB), and GCE Advanced Level exam scores may satisfy some prerequisite course requirements
