Overview of Haas Prerequisites

- Complete a minimum of 60 semester units
- Complete all major prerequisite courses listed below with a letter grade (must have a C- or higher)
 - If you repeated or took more than one course to fulfill a prerequisite, you must use the first attempt to satisfy the requirement.

Transfer Units

We will accept transfer credit / test credit for some prerequisites completed prior to your admission to Haas. Once you are a UC Berkeley student, however, you must take your remaining prerequisite requirements at UC Berkeley.
