WHAT DEADLINES SHOULD I KEEP IN MIND?

 - Book travel
- **5/13/2025**
 - Create Hello Fellow account, join groups
 - Upload resume to Hello Fellow
- **ASAP/Prior to OP**
 - All other checklist items



HOW DO I BOOK TRAVEL?

1. Steps 1 and 2 on your checklist must be completed and verified in order to receive your TravelBank login info.
2. After creating your account, request your \$300 travel stipend in TravelBank, which you will receive within one business day after completing the necessary steps.
3. Book your flight to Indianapolis. You **must** book travel using TravelBank.



WHAT IS COVERED BY THE CONSORTIUM?

- Other than your \$300 travel stipend, double occupancy hotel accommodations and most student meals during the conference are also covered by The Consortium.
- **Please note that The Consortium will book your hotel room - no action needed on your part!**
- Students are responsible for ground transportation to and from the airport/hotel/etc. and incidentals.



WHAT IS THE STUDENT LOOK BOOK?

- The Student Look Book is a collection of OP Professional Profiles submitted by our incoming Consortium class. It is distributed to our corporate partners prior to OP.
- Additionally, we distribute a resume book to our corporate partners using the resumes uploaded to your Hello Fellow profile.

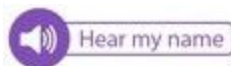
