



## INTERESTED IN MANAGEMENT CONSULTING? LOOKING FOR A STRETCH OPPORTUNITY?

Social Sector Solutions is an MBA-level Spring course that welcomes up to 10 select undergraduates every year. S3 is a unique, experiential learning course in which students tackle complex projects for real clients, on interdisciplinary teams led by an MBA, receiving coaching from experienced faculty and McKinsey consultants. S3 develops students' skills in consulting, problem solving, persuasion, and project management. Undergraduates operate in a team with MBAs and other graduate students, practicing data collection (qualitative and quantitative), analytical, client management and team skills in a professional setting. The course increases students' knowledge and experience working on the entrepreneurial challenges of leading nonprofit, public or social enterprise organizations.

S3 is offered by the Center for Social Sector Leadership at the Haas School of Business in partnership with McKinsey & Company. Since 2007, S3 has served 139 organizations and worked with 721 students and 87 different McKinsey coaches.

Teams are looking for select undergraduates who can:

- Work hard, contribute to the team
- Demonstrate a passion for the client's mission
- Bring skills such as finance, marketing, presentation skills and technology that will help to answer the clients' questions

The time commitment for the course is 8-12 hrs/week, including 3 hours in the required class Tuesday evenings 6:00-9:30pm in Haas' Innovation Lab.
