What is the Haas Video Interview?

- The video interview format is you recording yourself answering our set of questions to camera.
- Opportunity to showcase who you are and your experiences beyond your application.
- Highlight your personality, values, and motivations.

What is Haas Looking For?

- Authenticity, intellectual curiosity, leadership potential, and integrity.
- **Your motivations:** What drives you? What are your passions and values?

Talk About Your Experience

- Leadership experience can include various roles such as caring for a younger sibling, taking on organizational responsibilities, or contributing to community initiatives.
- Consider how you intend to contribute to the Haas community and your career goals.
- Show, don't tell: Be clear, concise and provide examples of your experience.

Be Prepared

- Practice telling your story out loud.
- You can prepare notes but do not read from a scripted response.
- **Time management:** It is recommended to budget around one minute and a half per question.

Relax

- Practice breathing through nerves.
- Remember, there are no right or wrong answers. It is about being authentic.
- Trust yourself! You have valuable experiences and insights.

Housekeeping Tips

- Dress based on your comfort; you will not be evaluated on your attire or background distractions.
- Test your equipment, including video and audio, to avoid technical issues. Make sure you have the latest version of browser downloaded.
 - We recommend using Google Chrome or Safari browsers.
 - Ensure you give your browser permission to access your mic and camera.
- Be comfortable and come as yourself.
- There is no expectation for you to use your time to address the Admissions team, you do not need to address us.
