



# **Cohort Reps**

Cohort Reps will be the key points of contact for the cohort, faculty, EWMBA Association and EWMBA Program Office around Academics and Student Experience Issues

- Cohort Reps will serve for the first 2 Semesters of the first year
- There will be Academic and Social Cohort Reps for each Cohort

#### Academic Cohort Rep (ACR)

- Academic Reps will be chosen by the Program Office in early August
- ACRs will be responsible for administering Mid-course and Final evaluations
- ACRs will serve as liaison between cohort and professors

#### Social Cohort Rep (SCR)

- Social Reps will be voted on by each Cohort in early August
- O SCRs will be responsible for keeping the cohort informed of any social events, either for your cohort or more broadly across the EW or MBA programs
